This time it was the Vessel MV BSLE NINA, which was brought in under our port agency for loading prestigious project cargo of L & T comprising 6 Pcs of Heavy Lift Cargo of size 12.395 x 5.398 x 5.875 Mtrs each weighing 216 MT and another 14 Pkgs with a total of 2472 cbm – 1314 MT meant for Kuwait. The other cargo loaded was 5415 cbm (1575 Nos – 4661.664 MT) huge coated pipes of Welspun for Umm Qssar. The entire operation was a real challenge owing to the adverse weather conditions. It was a mere exhibition of Seatech operation team's experience, expertise and collective efforts and despite the high tide and swell, the Heavy Cargo were loaded precisely and safely in record time, keeping a close vigil and alert round the clock. MV HEINO

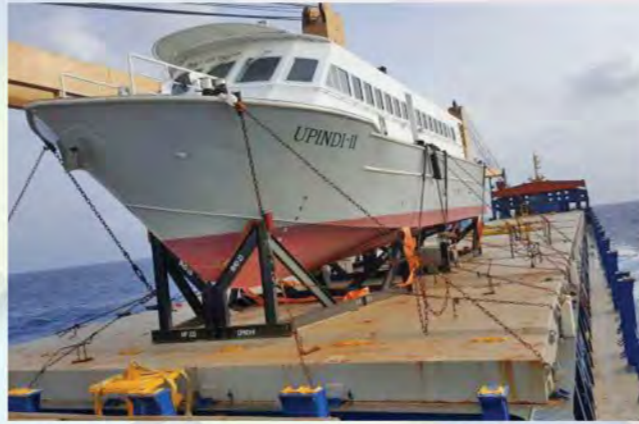
